Dear Parishioners,

One of the areas that has been sorely tried during these pandemic times has been that of marriage and family life. Radical changes of work patterns, school life, medical care and so forth have had to be faced. In many ways the response by the majority has been very determined and affirmative. It also seems to affirm the radical support that people can receive through those same building blocks of society: marriage and family life. In today's Gospel, Jesus is confronted by some Pharisees on the question of divorce as it was exercised by the Jewish rabbinical law of the day. Their intention of course was to trap him in his response. They fail to do so because he challenges them with God's original plan and purpose in this area which is spelt out in the first reading from the Book of Genesis for today. Marriage is fundamentally a divine institution with a summons to a lifelong partnership and the setting for the begetting and rearing of children. At the same time we have to acknowledge that there is often failure and great pain where the relationship has broken down. Because of this, the Church has for some time now developed programmes to help couples prepare for marriage and requires that pre-marriage courses be undertaken. Further, there are ongoing counselling services for couples who feel the need for help and assistance. Modern society often puts great pressures on couples that are not always recognised at the time. Prayerful thought and support is a constant need for all affected in any way.

Let us all seek to grow in the knowledge and understanding of the Father's love and compassion.
