Friday and Sunday this week are marked out for Remembrance of our war dead. On Friday, " Armistice day" many across our nation and abroad stood still on the 11 th hour of the 11 th day of the 11 th month, to remember those who had fallen in war. Originally established by King George V in 1919 to commemorate the terrible loss in the First World War, this day was replaced by Remembrance Sunday, the Sunday following the 11th. In recent years Armistice day has reappeared in response to the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, and the two days now serve for our country and others as a double reminder of the ultimate sacrifice.

In today's Gospel, Jesus warns of wars and other trials, both widespread and personal, but he reassures his disciples that eventually they will emerge victorious..." Your endurance will win you your lives". May we be granted the strength of faith to hold on during the times of testing and to keep our focus on the Lord of the Universe. Only in Him will we find true peace in a world of turmoil and strife.
