What does the month of November mean for you? The clocks change at the end of October, the children return to school and it seems that the world is suddenly darker as dusk arrives much earlier.. Summer is definitely over! The mild weather we enjoyed in early Autumn is now pushed aside and the great heating debate begins...shall we turn it on or wait a little longer with these awful price rises to pay?

The Church begins the month on a glorious note: All Saints, and we celebrate the Church Triumphant, the hosts of the blessed who live in the Presence. The next day is All Souls, the Church Penitent, as we pray and offer the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass particularly for our loved ones departed, those taken from our sight if only for a time. Remembrance for our War dead will be with us in a fortnight and the poppies remind us all of their sacrifices.

The Church Militant on Earth ..us..continue on our daily paths, perhaps with an extra layer if we live in Chippy! Soon we will be at the feast of Christ the King of the Universe, and then Advent signals another liturgical year beginning, as we lift our eyes to the Coming of the Lord and the joy of the Christ-child with His mother Mary and the silent saint Joseph.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus reminds his listeners that the Lord is God of the living because to Him there is no distinction between the living and the dead. Jesus said: " Do this in memory of me" and in this action of Holy Mass we are united with Him and also with those in the household of Faith who have travelled our paths before us.
